Gemstone CONNECT Mentor Position Fall 2017 - Spring 2018 Responsibilities

What is Gemstone CONNECT?

CONNECT is Gemstone's peer mentoring initiative that seeks to connect incoming students with current students throughout the course of the first-year. The CONNECT mentor role focuses on helping incoming students with their transition to the Gemstone Honors Program and the University of Maryland.

General Requirements:

- Must commit to a year long position (Fall 2017 and Spring 2018)
- Must be Gemstone student in good academic standing (minimum 3.0 GPA)
- Must be a rising sophomore, junior or senior in Gemstone.
- Must be enrolled in classes for Fall 2017 semester on campus (cannot study abroad)

Compensation:

• At the conclusion of each semester (fall and spring), CONNECT mentors will be compensated through 1-2 credits via GEMS208E, depending on # of hours staffed.

 - Sunday, Nov. 12th (ONLINE)
 - Sunday, Dec. 3rd (5:30-7:00pm)
- Attend CONNECT Kickoff and Welcome events. Events marked with a (**) are mandatory for all mentors unless you have a legitimate conflict and have notified Jessica.

- Staff 1-2 evening study hour/s per week (Sunday through Wednesday evenings, 6pm-12am)

- Conduct one *informal* in person mentoring session with mentees (Attend a Gemstone event, on campus sporting event, dinner at the Diner, coffee, etc. These informal mentoring sessions can be done in small groups)
